

Presenter Guide – Poster

Poster presentations will be held from Tuesday afternoon – 09 September 2014 to Friday evening - 12 September 2014 at the Main Hall of the Samarkand State University named after Alisher Navoi.

Poster boards will be pre-assigned and marked in accordance with your Abstract. Please feel free to approach the Poster Help Desk for assistance.

Prepare Your Poster

Each presenter is provided with a 2.1 meter high by 0.9 meter wide poster board. The presentation must cover the same material as the abstract submitted. Vertical/ Portrait format in A0 size is suggested. A0 Size Poster Measures: 841mm width x 1189mm height.

Place your Abstract Title and Authors' names prominently at the top of the poster to allow viewers to identify your abstract easily.

Presenter's Name must be underlined and in Bold Letterings.

Authors' names, e-mails and address information must be provided for in case the viewer is interested in contacting you for more information. You have complete freedom in displaying your information in figures, tables, text, photographs, etc in the poster. Include the background of your research followed by results and conclusions. A successful poster presentation depends on how well you convey information to an interested audience.

Set Up Your Poster

Posters should be set-up by 17:30pm 09 September 2014.

Posters are scheduled to be on display from for all days of the Conference.

Interactive forum is as scheduled and presenters are required to be at their posters during poster viewing times. Adhesive tapes and scissors are available at the Poster Help Desk nearby. If you have special needs for your poster presentation, please bring those supplies with you to the meeting.

Remove Your Poster

Posters must be removed after the viewing time in the end of the Conference.
